

HCS (Judicial) Examination Pattern

The HCS (Judicial) exam will consist of three stages i.e.

Stage 1 - Preliminary Exam

The Preliminary Examination shall be of objective type with multiplechoice questions as given below:

Stage 2 - Main Exam

The Main Examination shall consist of six papers five written and a viva voce. The description of papers and the syllabus shall be as under:

V Language Hindi (in Devnagri Script). Translation of an English passage into Hindi: 20. Explanation of Hindi passage in prose and poetry in the same language: 30. Composition 100 Marks (essay), idioms and corrections: 50 3 Hrs.

VI Viva Voca To judge the personal qualities of the candidates. The vivavoce shall relate to the matters of general interest and is intended to test the candidates' alertness, intelligence and general outlook. it shall be conducted in English.

Stage 3 - Vica Voca

Candidates thrice the number of posts in order of merit of Main Examination will be called for viva-voce.

The candidate shall also be tested for his analytical skills and aptitude. The standard of the question paper shall be of Law graduate level.
